



Greetings to the Superstition Mountain Chapter.

The clock continues to tick away on appropriations at the federal level. As of this afternoon, here are the current stats: House (7 Of 12 Bills Passed), Senate (3 Of 12 Bills Passed), Both Chambers (0 Of 12), Vetoed (0 Of 12), Signed by the President (0 Of 12). Not a good record. Especially considering that this is for the Federal Fiscal Year 2024 which is halfway over. I have sighed twice typing this.

Federal

As you know, MOAA has been actively engaged in a number of federal issues which impact our service members. Last month I gave you a list of legislation pending and the links to help you reach out in support. Here are a few more for you, courtesy of our State MOAA:

Quality of Life 'Erosion' Poses Dire Threat to the Force, Lawmakers Say. The chair and ranking member of the House Armed Services Committee and the leaders of that committee's Quality of Life Panel, have sent a letter addressing the following key quality of life issues to President Biden. The letter seeks "significantly more attention and resources" in the president's annual budget request, expected March 11, to address five key quality of life issues:

- Health and safety concerns with barracks and single-family housing.
- Inadequate compensation can lead to food insecurity, among other financial stressors.
- A lack of access to quality medical care, especially behavioral care.
- Childcare shortages, "especially in high-cost and remote areas."
- Spouse employment concerns, driven by frequent military moves and license portability issues.

TAKE ACTION: Urge Your Legislators to Improve the Quality of Life of Our Servicemembers

Elizabeth Dole Home and Community Based Services for Veterans and Caregivers Act (H.R. 542 and S. 141): would help veterans and their caregivers transition between caregiver support programs, assess the level of care they need, expand mental health services, and improve communication and coordination between veterans and their families and veterans service organizations.

TAKE ACTION: Urge Your Legislators to Support H.R. 542 and Provisions in S. 141

Expanding Veterans' Options for Long Term Care Act (H.R. 1815 and S. 495) would allow the VA to launch a pilot program to look at the effectiveness of paying for assisted living services. Currently, the VA is unable to pay room and board expenses at these facilities.

TAKE ACTION: <u>Urge Your Legislators to Support H.R. 1815 and S. 495</u>

Veteran Caregiver Application and Appeals Reform (CARE) Act (S. 1792 and H.R. 4518) allows VSOs and nonprofit organizations to advocate for that population within the Veterans Health Administration (VHA). The CARE Act would provide a standardized process for training and qualifying organizations to assist caregivers and veterans in navigating VHA programs.

TAKE ACTION: Urge Your Legislators to Support the CARE Act

The Major Richard Star Act (H.R. 1282/S. 344) in the next National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA). The point that must be advanced is that support to the all-volunteer force must overcome cost concerns.

TAKE ACTION: Ask Your Lawmakers to include the Major Richard Star Act in the FY 2025 NDAA

We have discussed many of these like the MAJ Star Act, as well as the CARE Act. These are bills designed to help veterans and retirees. We are close to getting these bills a proper vote. Your help is vital. Reach out to your Congressman and Senator by using the link below.

State Issues

SB1413 Provides an income tax elimination for the Uniformed Servicemembers of NOAA and USPHS in AZ. This bill has been approved by both the Commerce and Rules committee and will soon move to the Senate floor for a vote and then on to the House. Please contact your Arizona Senators and urge them to support SB1413. The sooner we get this through the Senate, the sooner we can start working on the House for passage this session! Thanks for your continued great work on this issue!

PLEASE ACT NOW: Please contact your senators so SB1413 can get to the House ASAP.

There are, truly, only a few bills with such little information on them, which I plan to monitor. Here are two to watch.

- HB2390 Property Tax Exemption; Combat Veterans
 Amends Section 42-11111, ARS; Relating to property tax exemptions. Exemption for property; widows/widowers, persons with total and permanent disability, veterans with a disability.
- HB2392 Income Tax; subtraction; care expenses
 Amends Section 43-1022, ARS; Relating to individual income tax. Individual income tax; subtractions from AZ gross income, U.S. Government Retirement.


