1925/2025

Ever wondered what happened 100 years ago this year? It was a doozie!

- The **Jazz Age** began! Social conventions were thrown off, and a flamboyant culture arose.
- <u>"The Great Gatsby,"</u> capturing the rise of the Jazz Age, was penned by F. Scott Fitzgerald.
- A silent horror film, "The Phantom of the Opera" was released to theaters. Lon Chaney starred as the Phantom.
- **Mount Rushmore** was dedicated with a flag ceremony as a national memorial. However, it was not completed until 1941.
- Adolf Hitler published <u>"Mein Kampf."</u> It was written in prison, and was his manifesto. It was a wild success!
- John T. Scopes, a Tennessee High School teacher, was tried for teaching the theory of evolution in a public school, a violation of Tennessee's *Butler Act*. **William Jennings Bryan** headed the prosecution, while **Clarence Darrow** joined the ACLU for the Defense. Scopes was found guilty, but on appeal the conviction was overturned on a technicality, which had to do with the fine. It is referred to as the "Scopes Trial." The U.S. Supreme Court overturned a similar law in Arkansas, finding that it violated the First Amendment. This boosted the theory of Evolution significantly and legitimized its teaching.
- Edwin Hubble revealed galaxies beyond the Milky Way.
- Miriam A. Ferguson became the **first female Governor** of Texas.

- The Soviet Union commemorated the 1st anniversary of Lenin's death.
- Italian Fascist leader, **Benito Mussolini**, won a seat in Italy's Parliament. He had been working for years to gain power and worked slowly, "eroding democratic constitutions until the moment came for them to be done away with entirely." On January 3, 1925, Mussolini "solidified" his dictatorship in Italy in a speech to Parliament. He declared his right to supreme power, which effectively made him the dictator of Italy.
- The **Ku Klux Klan** made a show of force in Washington D.C. They marched in full regalia, nearly 40,000 members strong, down Pennsylvania Avenue.
- "The Great Race of Mercy" relayed diphtheria antitoxin by dog sled across the U.S. Territory of Alaska to Nome to combat an epidemic. The animated movie "Balto" recreates this feat.
- A **total solar eclipse** passed over Geneva, Switzerland for the first time since the 18th century. There was a 2-minute period of total darkness, creating quite a spectacle!
- The 20th Amendment to the Constitution was adopted, changing the presidential inauguration from March 4th to January 20th.
- "The New Yorker" magazine debuted.
